Wastewater Collection System Improvements

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the **Flippin City Hall** located at **239 East Main Street, Flippin, Arkansas 72634**, until **Wednesday, September 27, 2023**, at **10:00 a.m.** local time. At that time the Bids received will be **publicly** opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

Pipe bursting of approximately 35,297-l.f. of gravity sewer mains, installation of approximately 12,579-l.f. of gravity sewer mains, sewer service connections, installation of three (3) new sewer lift stations and associated force mains, and other associated appurtenances.

Bids are requested for the following Contract: **Wastewater Collection System Improvements**

Owner anticipates that the Project's total bid price will be approximately **\$4,200,000.00**. The Project has an expected duration of **three hundred (300) consecutive calendar** days.
